

OKC Portable Toilets Terms & Conditions

Portable toilets are provided for the purpose of handling human waste. Therefore, no refuse, hazardous waste or hazardous materials shall be placed in a portable toilet. OKC Portable Toilets is not licensed to handle hazardous waste and the facilities where we dispose of sewage will not accept it.

No rags, clothing, trash, or other material should be placed in the toilet. Toilets, and the extraction system, are designed for human waste and toilet paper only. Other materials will clog the system. Additional fees may be assessed in cases of violations which clog or damage our systems.

Toilets, not accessible to truck on service days, will not be serviced and additional trip charges may be incurred to reschedule the service. Trucks must be able to get within 15 ft of the toilet on a hard packed surface (concrete, asphalt, gravel, etc).

Customer acknowledges they have care, custody, and control of the equipment owned by OKC Portable Toilets and accepts responsibility and liabilities for the use of the equipment and it's contents. THEREFORE, THE CUSTOMER EXPRESSLY AGREES TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS OKC PORTABLE TOILETS FROM AND AGAINST ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE TO PROPERTY OR INJUST TO OR INJURY TO OR DEATH OF PERSON OR PERSONS RESULTING FROM OR ARISING IN ANY MANNER OUT OF CUSTOMER'S USE OF THE EQUIPMENT FURNISHED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT.

Customer agrees to use the portable toilet, or other rented equipment, with care and responsibility. The Customer acknowledges that any damage from misuse, moving, or abuse will be the Customer's responsibility. The Customer agrees to pay for any damages to the portable toilet, or other equipment, which occurs during the rental process.

Customer acknowledges that portable toilets, or other equipment, rented from OKC Portable Toilets remains the property of OKC Portable Toilets. Customer agrees not to move or relocate the rented equipment without written approval from OKC Portable Toilets.

Customer acknowledges Service Period is a 28 day cycle and continuous renewal until Customer requests termination of the rental. The Service Period Fee is assessed on Day 1 of each Service Period. No Refunds for termination of the rental during the current Service Period. Each Service Period rental includes a maximum of either: (a) 3 weekly cleanings, and a pick-up or (b) 4 weekly cleanings.

OKC Portable Toilets reserves the right to cancel any rental at any point during the rental period. In the event OKC Portable Toilets cancels the rental, Customer will receive a pro-rated refund for that Service Period. However, OKC Portable Toilets will not be responsible for any other costs incurred by the customer for such cancellation.
